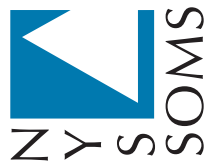

SPEAKER



Dr. Jensen graduated from the University of Utah. He attended dental school at Northwestern and completed his oral surgery residency at the University of Michigan. He currently has a private oral surgery practice in Greenwood Village, Colorado which focuses on implants and bone graft reconstruction. Dr. Jensen has many publications and he lectures widely throughout the world. He was

board certified in 1982 and was the President of the Academy of Osseointegration Foundation in 2006. Dr. Jensen and his wife, Marty, have 3 children and 8 grandchildren.

PRESENTATION

The time has come for an orthognathic surgical approach to the treatment of alveolar atrophy using total jaw or alveolar segmental osteotomies. In addition, the necessary tool kit for dental implant reconstruction now must include piezosurgery, biomimetics and prosthodontic treatment planning skills. More than ever, the oral and maxillofacial surgeon stands at the cross roads where the pendulum swings, where implant protocols are swiftly moving back and forth, gliding seemingly out of reach.

The oral maxillofacial surgeon must provide a quicker, simpler approach to surgical care to minimize the bone grafting requirement and overall cost of care. Today's fad is for implants to be placed, to become immediately loaded and at the same time, must be esthetically pleasing. Will this new demand from both patients and restorative practioners alike pass the test of time?

Let's cool down a little, wait and enjoy the pendulum swinging back using osteoperiosteal flaps.
