

Below are all the New York State legislative bills that NYSDA is either supporting, opposing, or monitoring in the current two year legislative cycle. The bills have the official bill titles, the bill history, and current status. Note that some of the official bill titles give somewhat weak descriptions of the bills, but the NYSDA Council on Governmental Affairs is happy to provide further explanations and is working on adding that to this site.

A word on the categories – **SUPPORT** and **OPPOSE** are self-explanatory and align with NYSDA policy positions. **MONITOR** is a multifaceted category taking in bills on which NYSDA has no definite policy position but which might have some effect on dentistry, or which are unlikely to advance with lobbying efforts or do not require lobbying efforts to defeat but bear keeping an eye on in case those realities suddenly change, or do not apply to dentistry now but might be amended down the road to do so, or, more rarely, are bills on which taking a firm position has been determined by the Council on Governmental Affairs to be an unwise political commitment given the nature of the issue and relationships with sponsors and/or agencies.
