Report Council on Dental Health Planning and Hospital Dentistry

- 1 The Council on Dental Health Planning and Hospital Dentistry (CDHPHD) met on
- 2 September 23, 2024, by Zoom and on March 21, 2025, at the Marriott Hotel, Albany,
- 3 NY. In addition to their regular meeting on March 21, the Council also met jointly with
- 4 the Council on Dental Education and Licensure (CDEL) prior to their individual meeting.
- 5 Minutes of these meetings are on file in the NYSDA office and have been distributed to
- 6 the Board of Trustees and to component presidents, presidents-elect, component
- 7 executive directors and council chairs.

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- **ADA Council on Advocacy for Access and Prevention (CAAP) Report:** The Council was provided with reports from CAAP meetings held in July 2024 and January 2025.
- 11 Review of Resolution 14H-2024, Dentist and Dental Hygienist Licensure Compact:
- 12 At its 2024 House of Delegates meeting, the NYSDA House adopted Resolution 14H-
- 13 2024, which asked that the appropriate councils evaluate the Dentist and Dental
- 14 Hygienist Licensure Compact model. The Board formally referred the resolution to the
- 15 Council on Dental Practice for recommendations to the 2025 HOD but also asked that
- the Council on Dental Health Planning and Hospital Dentistry consider the matter.
- 17 The Council discussed the licensure compact at both of its meetings in addition to
- attending a webinar hosted by the American Dental Association on January 27, 2025.
- 19 The members felt it was best to wait to see how the licensure compact progressed
- 20 before encouraging New York State to join. A related resolution is appended to this
- 21 report.
- 22 Review of Resolution 15H-2024, Expediated Licensure and Foreign-Trained
- 23 **Dentists:** At its 2024 House of Delegates meeting, the NYSDA House adopted
- 24 Resolution 15H-2024, which asked that the appropriate councils evaluate expediated
- 25 licensure and additional training options for foreign-trained dentists. The Board formally
- 26 referred the resolution to the Council on Dental Education and Licensure for
- 27 recommendations to the 2025 HOD but also asked that the CDHPHD consider the
- 28 matter.

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29 The Council discussed the formation of a task force to further evaluate the intended

- direction of Resolution 15H-2024 and its relationship to access to care and foreign-
- trained dentists. A related resolution is appended to this report.
- Review of Resolution 16H-2024, PGY-1: At its 2024 House of Delegates meeting, the
- 33 NYSDA House adopted Resolution 16H-2024, which asked that the appropriate
- 34 councils evaluate the PGY-1 pathway to licensure model and bring recommendations to
- 35 the 2025 HOD. The NYSDA Board formally referred the resolution to the CDHPHD and
- 36 the CDEL. Both councils formed subcommittees and held joint meetings to evaluate the
- PGY-1 model and its potential implications on the state's dental workforce. A resolution
- submitted jointly by the CDEL and the CDHPHD is Resolution 10.
- 39 **Nomination of Council Chair:** The Council voted unanimously to recommend Dr.
- 40 Maria C. Maranga of the Suffolk County Dental Society to incoming NYSDA President
- Dr. Maurice L. Edwards for consideration for appointment to the position of Council
- 42 Chair from June 2025 to June 2026. If approved, this will be Dr. Maranga's first year as
