### Dues for Active Members

1 **Background Statement:** In accordance with Chapter III, Section 130Ad, and Chapter V,  
 2 Section 110G, of the *Bylaws*, a resolution to establish the dues of active members for the  
 3 following year shall be proposed at each Annual Meeting by the Board of Trustees.

4  
 5 The 2026 Budget being submitted to the House includes a cash flow deficit of \$268,872.  
 6 Any actual loss will be covered by excess assets in the General and Reserve funds.

7  
 8 Considering we had no dues increase in 2025, the Board feels it appropriate to propose an  
 9 inflationary increase in 2026 so that our finances do not experience tremendous loss. The  
 10 Board is suggesting a \$19 dues increase; just under 3%. Such increase should produce an  
 11 additional \$116,490 in revenue to further reduce the projected deficit to \$152,382.

 13 Notwithstanding any subsequent changes to the current 2026 Budget, the Board proposes the  
 14 following resolution:

 16 **Resolved,** that the dues of active members of the New York State Dental Association  
 17 shall be six hundred sixty-two dollars (\$662), effective January 1, 2026.
